The US-176 Widening Phase 1 Project is a bid-build project that includes widening a total of 4.7 miles of US-176 between Sheep Island Rd. & US-17A from 2 to 4 lanes. It includes turn lanes, raised concrete medians, signal & intersection improvements, as well as extensive water & sewer relocations.



#### **PROJECT ACTIVITIES**

#### **In-Contract Utility Relocation**

In-contract BCWS water installation has been substantially completed. Final walk-through will be scheduled for September 2025.

#### **Construction Activities**

- Storm installation has been completed on St. James Ave. and is almost complete on US 17A.
- L. Dean Weaver Co. is working to tie in all concrete sections and pave all asphalt base between Cane Bay / North Creek Drive intersection and Domingo Drive to allow Sanders to continue with intermediate course paving.
- Signal work at Nexton Pkwy and Cane Bay Blvd intersections has been completed (signal adjustments to be made once traffic is in final configuration).
- Change Order 09 (Marshall Acres Drive Turn Lane) was executed to add \$114,566.96 and 24 days to the Contract.
